REPORT ON ACTIVITIES SINCE THE THIRD MEETING OF THE BOARD HELD ON 27TH AUGUST 1994

I. (a). <u>FINANCE</u>: The Governing Board at its 3rd Meeting held on 27th August 1994 approved the recommendation of the Finance Committee and fixed the Revised Budget for the year 1994-95 for Kalakshetra Foundation as under:

- 1. Non Plan: Recurring expenditure Rs. 85.99 lakhs
- 2. Plan : Capital expenditure Rs. 100.21 lakhs (after deducting revenue income of Rs. 32.39 lakhs).

Kalakshetra Foundation has incurred the following expenditure till 30th November 1994:

Recurring: 44.86 lakhs

Capital: 24.08 lakhs

TOTAL 68.94 lakhs

Department of Culture, Government of India released the first instalment of grant amounting to Rs. 25.00 lakhs on 21-9-94. On the basis of expenditure incurred till 31st October 1994, a request has been made for release of a second instalment of Rs. 25.00 lakhs and this is expected to be released by the end of December, 1994. It may be seen that on the basis of expenditure actually incurred and also considering the commitments on hand, we need a further grant of Rs. 136.20 lakhs. (Non-plan (recurring) and plan capital). For this purpose the Government of India has to provide for a supplementary grant amounting to Rs136.20 lakhs.

(b).Pension Fund: It may be recalled that at the last meeting, on the recommendation of the Finance Committee, the Governing Board approved, in principle, the introduction of a Pension Scheme for the employees of the Foundation on and from 1.10.93. The Department of Culture has been approached for approval of the proposal and also for providing a matching contribution of Rs.25.00 lakhs towards the pension fund of Kalakshetra Foundation. This matter is under consideration of the Department of Culture.

(c)Group Insurance Scheme: The Group Insurance Scheme has been introduced for the regular employees of the Kalakshetra Foundation with effect from 1.11.93. 116 members have enrolled themselves in the Scheme and the monthly contribution of the members has come to Rs. 4860.00.

II Major Maintentence works etc.

- (a). Maintenance: Re-roofing with Mangalore Tiles has been executed in the following buildings to prevent leakage during the rainy season:
- 1. Central Administration Office
- 2. Main building of B.A.S.S.School
- 3. Physics & Chemistry Laboratory Block of B.A.S.S.School; and
- 4. Five staff quarters
